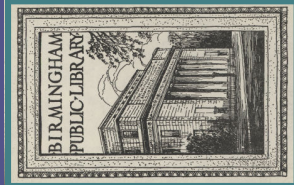

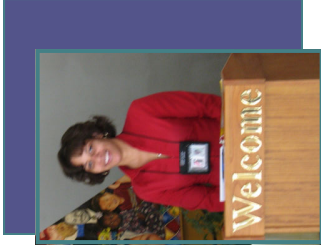

Staff

- 301 well-trained employees, more than 80 master's degrees
- 18.9 hours of training per person each year
- National committee positions in the American Library Association and the Public Library Association
- National participation in the Urban Libraries Council and the Innovative Interfaces Users Group
- Presenters at county, state and national meetings and conventions and at international conferences in Iceland and England
- Contributor to Alabama Mosaic
- Contributor to the Encyclopedia of Alabama

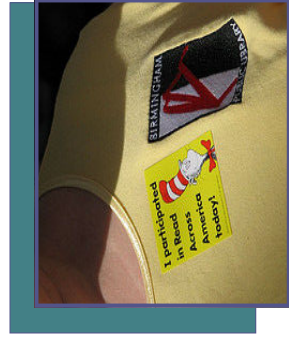
